

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES
TO THE 2020 UTAH FISHING GUIDEBOOK
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH**

I, Michal Fowls, by authority granted in Section 23-14-8 of the Wildlife Resources Code of Utah declare an emergency amendment to the 2020 Utah Fishing Guidebook. The following has been amended:

Mammoth Creek, including all tributaries, lakes, and ponds, excluding Castle Creek (Garfield and Iron Counties)

Upstream of Forest Road 50 (Mammoth Creek cutoff road): Limit 8 trout
Castle Creek (tributary to Mammoth Creek): Limit un-changed and remains at 4 trout

This change is effective May 11, 2020 and will remain in effect until December 31, 2020.

The upper Mammoth Creek drainage will be treated with rotenone in 2020 in order to remove nonnative trout. This project is part of an effort to restore native Bonneville cutthroat trout to the drainage upstream of Mammoth Spring. This change allows anglers to harvest additional trout prior to the rotenone treatment. Castle Creek has been previously treated with rotenone as part of this project and will not be re-treated in 2020.

All other rules established in the 2020 Utah Fishing Guidebook remain in effect.
