

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES  
TO THE 2023 UTAH FISHING GUIDEBOOK  
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING  
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH**

I, Justin Shirley, by authority granted in Section 23A-1-201 of the Wildlife Resources Code of Utah declare and emergency amendments to the 2023 and 2024 Utah Fishing Guidebooks. The following has been amended:

**Mayor's Pond (Box Elder County):**

- 8 fish

This change is effective immediately and will remain in effect until January 31, 2024.

Brigham City will be dredging Mayor's Pond in January 2024 due to extensive sedimentation that occurred during spring runoff in 2023. The Division stocked this pond in fall 2023. It is unlikely that stocked fish will survive the dredging efforts. With that in mind, the Division is authorizing a harvest limit of 8 fish per person. The intent of this emergency regulation is to provide anglers with an opportunity to remove an increased number of fish ahead of dredging. It is the Division's goal through this liberalized harvest limit and Division led salvage efforts to remove a significant portion of the fish from Mayor's Pond before the reservoir is dredged.

All other rules established in the 2023 and 2024 Utah Fishing Guidebooks remain in effect.
